UNITS 5-8: GLORIOUS GALAXY — Adventures in the Debut of God's Son

Overview

UNITS 5-8 Core Bible Stories feature God's redemptive promises to Ruth and Esther, the faith of Job, Jonah and Daniel, and the actions of Jesus' early followers—with correlating Unit Bible Passages and songs such as Psalm 1:6 ("The Lord watches over the way of the righteous") and Prov. 3:3-4 ("Let love and faithfulness never leave you").

Targets

By the end of Kindergarten UNITS 5-8, students will accomplish the following 25 spiritual responses:

- 1. Believe that obeying God is always the right way to go.
- 2. Remember that the righteous live by believing in God.
- 3. Realize that the unbelieving will perish without God.
- 4. Trust that only God can give us true wisdom to follow Him.
- 5. Decide to never let our sincere love for God leave us.
- 6. Let our love for God shine in the sight of God and man.
- 7. Celebrate that God gives us favor when we are true to Him.
- 8. Remember to be set apart for God in the view of others.
- 9. Know that God always protects those who are faithful to Him.
- 10. Protect your heart by being devoted and faithful to God.
- 11. Celebrate that whoever believes in Jesus has eternal life.
- 12. Be thankful that God saved the day through His only Son.
- 13. Remember that Jesus is happy when one sinner turns to Him.
- 14. Trust that whoever has the Son of God has eternal life.
- 15. Remember that God loved us so much that He gave His Son.
- 16. Realize that we do not have eternal life without God's Son.
- 17. Share with friends that God loves us and gave us eternal life.
- 18. Receive the truth about Jesus with the simple faith of a child.
- 19. Remember that God the Father wants us to follow His Son.
- 20. Be with believers in Jesus so that we can encourage each other.
- 21. Remember that the good news of Jesus is for the whole world.
- 22. Be joyful that believers in Jesus share the gift of the Holy Spirit.
- 23. Remember to be in God's house where friends in Christ are free.
- 24. Decide how we can encourage one another to live for Jesus.
- 25. Be thankful for friends who believe that Jesus is God's Son.
