

Bible REPLAY Curriculum Grade 1

UNITS 1-4: FEARLESS FRONTIER — Adventures in the Calling of God's Champions

Overview

UNITS 1-4 Core Bible Stories feature God's covenant with man through the flood, the faith of Abraham, Deborah, Samuel and Joseph, and the arrival of Christ—with correlating Unit Bible Passages and songs such as Isaiah 43:1-2 ("Fear not, for I have redeemed you") and Galatians 4:4-5 ("God sent his Son ... to redeem those under law").

Targets

By the end of Grade 1 UNITS 1-4, students will accomplish the following 25 spiritual responses:

1. Recognize that God is our best and only eternal friend.
2. Know that God's love for us is great because it never ends.
3. Celebrate that God's love protects us from sin's defeat.
4. Trust that even when we fail God, He doesn't give up on us.
5. Remember that God meets our needs over and over again.
6. Celebrate every morning as a new day to depend on God.
7. Know that God's compassions and mercies never fail or end.
8. Count on God to be our best friend even on hard or sad days.
9. Be confident that God says, "You are mine" to His children.
10. Believe that when challenges come, God doesn't leave us.
11. Choose to trust God over anything that we might fear.
12. Have no fear knowing that God promises to be with us.
13. Trust that God always cares for us through the rough times.
14. Know that God protected His people and walks with us today.
15. Remember that our faith in God will shine before men.
16. Trust that God protects us when we are about pleasing Him.
17. Give our challenges over to the Lord, who is always faithful.
18. Let our righteousness shine so that men see God in us.
19. Love God and others as a beacon of light for the world.
20. Believe that through Jesus we have the right to belong to God.
21. Know that Jesus saved us when we were helpless in our sin.
22. Believe that Jesus paid our ransom or the penalty for our sin.
23. Celebrate that God adopts us as children through faith in Jesus.
24. Share that Jesus saves us from our sins since the law cannot.
25. Be confident that God planned the perfect time to send his Son.
