## Bible REPLAY Curriculum Grade 2

## UNITS 5-8: MIGHTY MOUNTAIN — Adventures in the Triumph of God's Son

## Overview

UNITS 5-8 Core Bible Stories feature the origin, purpose, and value of God's Word, the delivery of salvation in Christ, and the power of the fruit of the Spirit—with correlating Unit Bible Passages and songs such as Isaiah 53:5 ("He was pierced for our transgressions.") and Galatians 5:22-23 ("But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace ...").

## Targets

By the end of Grade 2 UNITS 5-8, students will accomplish the following 25 spiritual responses:

- 1. Obey God by keeping His words (the Bible) upon our lips both day and night.
- 2. Be careful to do everything written in God's Word to prosper and have success.
- 3. Understand the Bible as "God's Word" since the writers were inspired by God.
- 4. Be thankful that the Bible shows us who God is and how He saved us from our sin.
- 5. Believe that doing what God says sets us free from sin and puts us on the right path.
- 6. Acknowledge that we are blessed when we meditate on or think about God's Word.
- 7. Be comforted that God's Word is the same today, yesterday, and for all eternity.
- 8. Know without a doubt that we are reconciled or reunited with God through Christ.
- 9. Urgently share with friends that God gave Jesus (who had no sin) to take on our sin.
- 10. Be amazed that through our faith in Jesus we might become righteous in God's sight.
- 11. Celebrate the truth that God took our sin from us when His Son died on the cross.
- 12. Believe that the Son of God became our sin so that were made right with God.
- 13. Receive and declare the truth that God took away our sin by sacrificing His Son.
- 14. Know that Jesus knew He would die on the cross as part of God's plan to save us.
- 15. Remember Isaiah's prophetic words that by Jesus' wounds we would be healed.
- 16. Rejoice that Jesus was pierced and crushed, for His punishment brought us peace.
- 17. Know that Jesus' death and resurrection finished God's work for our salvation.
- 18. Celebrate that in Jesus there is a stream to heaven flowing out to all who believe.
- 19. Realize that it is by the wounds of Jesus that we are healed or forgiven for our sins.
- 20. Recognize that Jesus sent us His Holy Spirit to help us love Him and walk His way.
- 21. Remember that the fruit of the Spirit communicates to others that Jesus is in us.
- 22. Appreciate that the Holy Spirit helps us to obey God and avoid ungodly choices.
- 23. Recall that the greatest fruit of the Spirit is love, which God generously gave to us.
- 24. Live with patience, kindness, and goodness to show the Spirit's fruit inside us.
- 25. Obey God by following the Spirit's leading to live with gentleness and self-control.
